Montvale's 364 acres are now protected by a permanent land conservation easement. Thanks to Sam Furrow, who purchased the property in 2008 and who has established the easement through the Foothills Land Conservancy, the land is protected from commercial development. Sam is leasing the historic Blount County property to Harmony while we are raising funds to purchase the property for use as a therapeutic center for children and families and the community – the Harmony Family Center at Montvale.

The land conservation easement prevents commercial and residential development protects Montvale's historic land, its natural habitat, and the environment. Finally this easement ensures that the land at Montvale will always be used to benefit children and families.
